 Adobe Audition recognizes and makes available audio effects that are installed with Adobe Premiere Pro. This means any audio work you begin in Adobe Premiere Pro can be continued in Adobe Audition while maintaining all the effects and edits you initially performed.

Marker recognition

 Add markers in an Adobe Premiere Pro sequence to use later for audio editing in Adobe Audition 2.0. Markers are included when your sequence is exported as an AVI file, and they appear in Multitrack View when the AVI file is imported into Adobe Audition. Using these markers makes it easier to align soundtrack edits correctly.
