

CAUTIONS



Pay attention to all warning labels and instructions printed on the exterior of your Fog Machine

Danger of electric shock

- Keep this device dry.
- For indoor operations only. Not designed for outdoor use.
- For the 110V models, use 3-prong grounded electrical outlet only. Prior to use, check the specification label carefully and ensure correct power is sent to the machine.
- Unplug machine before filling its fluid tank.
- Keep machine upright.
- Turn off or unplug machine, when it is not in use.
- The machine is not water-proof. If the machine gets wet, unplug and stop using it immediately.
- No user serviceable parts inside. If service is in need, contact a dealer or an qualified service personnel.

Danger of burns

- For adult use only. Machine must be placed out of the reach of children. Never leave the unit running unattended.
- Keep nozzle at least 50cm (20 inch) away from contacting anything while in operation. The fog output around nozzle is very hot. It could be close to or above 300°C (600°F)
- Never aim the output nozzle at people.
- Locate the machine in a well-ventilated area. Never block the unit's ventilation. Give at least 20cm (8 inch) space around the machine.
- Let machine cool down to room temperature, if cleaning or service must be carried out.

Danger of explosion

- Never add flammable liquids of any kind (oil, gas, perfume) to the fog liquid.
- Only use water-based fog fluids recommended by the machine's manufacturer. Always make sure
 there is sufficient fog fluids in the fluid tank. Operating this unit without fog fluid can cause
 damages to the pump and the heater.
- If machine fails to work properly, discontinue operation immediately. Empty the fluid tank and pack the unit securely (preferably in the original packing box), and return it to your dealer for inspection.
- Empty fluid tank before transporting machine.

OPERATION

- Plug power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. Turn power switch on rear of unit to "ON" position. The machine starts to warm up and the red light on the remote control will be on. When warm-up is complete the red light is off.
- To emit fog, press the button on the remote and hold for the desired length of time.
- The remote unit's light will cycle on and off as the machine re-heats to the proper operating temperature.
- For further information on operating your Antari Fog Machine, see the section titled, "Remote Control Operation".

INSTALLATION

The FXW-800 fog machine includes a mounting bracket designed for overhead installation. This bracket allows the unit to be hung from lighting equipment trussing or other suitable supports. The unit can also be operated at floor level or sitting on any regular surface as well. If the unit is to be mounted using the bracket, it is important that the fog does not shoot directly at any one's face. Therefore, do not point the nozzle in a direction that will aim directly at a person. Whatever installation method you choose, do not allow the unit to have more than a 15 degree angle of inclination.
